Spectacular Sea-Eagles

Day 1 Fly to Trondheim for transfer (approx 3 hours) to our Flatanger base and dinner.

Days 2-5 Weather willing we plan for a total of 8 trips to photograph the Sea-Eagles from our guide Ole-Martin Dahle's flat-bottomed fishing boat, from which he will guide us into the best positions for each birds approach to his carefully placed fish. The birds are well accustomed to this routine and can pass as close as 10metres from us! Each trip should give us several feeding dives. These trips will be in the early morning and the evening to ensure that we are working in the best possible light to capture the dramatic opportunities, and during the middle part of the day there will be the chance to rest or visit a local forest hide for small bird and red squirrel photography too.

Day 6 Return to Trondheim airport for homeward flight connections.

Recommended Kit: You will need to provide your own photographic equipment - 300mm lens is absolutely ideal for this trip as the fish will generally be around 25m from the boat, and this will allow for frame filling images of the eagles as they approach and collect it. You will be handholding so tripod is only necessary if you intend spending some daytime hours in the forest hides. There are always landscape opportunities here too, so bring appropriate lenses. If you would like to talk through our camera and lens hire options for this trip then please just ask.

Additional information:

The inshore waters where the photography takes place is generally calm, but there can be occasional choppy spray so a good waterproof top (and possibly over trousers) can be of benefit.
